Since 2004, Epsilon has been providing support to children in situations of distress and vulnerability in developing countries, focusing on areas such as healthcare, education, nutrition, and water.

The association is composed solely of volunteers. All projects have zero overhead costs: 100% of the funds raised are dedicated to the causes!

Helping children in developing countries with basic needs such as nutrition, healthcare, education, and water.



Vision

Creating sustainable development and achieving tangible impact on as many children and adolescents aged 0 to 18 in developing countries through small, measurable projects achievable within less than a year.

Examples of completed projects



Nutrition
Rwanda

In 2009, we built a **new nutrition centre in Rutongo** and have been supporting it ever since by covering all the **food expenses of the children receiving care and suffering from severe malnutrition-related diseases**. The centre also provides nutrition education to the children's families.



Healthcare
Benin

We have been supporting the **St. Jean de Dieu** hospital in Tanguieta since 2006. We allocate the funds to the **paediatrics and neonatology wards and the nutrition centre**, to ensure that the children receive adequate sanitary equipment, care and nutrition.



Education
Malawi

In 2023, Epsilon continued to **support the schools in the Rumphi district** by donating nearly 500 classroom desks, 32 solar lamps, 50 footballs and football nets to improve the school environment and consequently the performance of the children.



Water
Tanzania

Since 2022, with the collaboration of Radici Globali, we have been supporting the **construction of aqueducts for the Maasai community in the Mkuru district**, where drinking water sources are tens of kilometres away from the villages and the situation is aggravated by climate change.

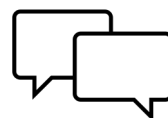

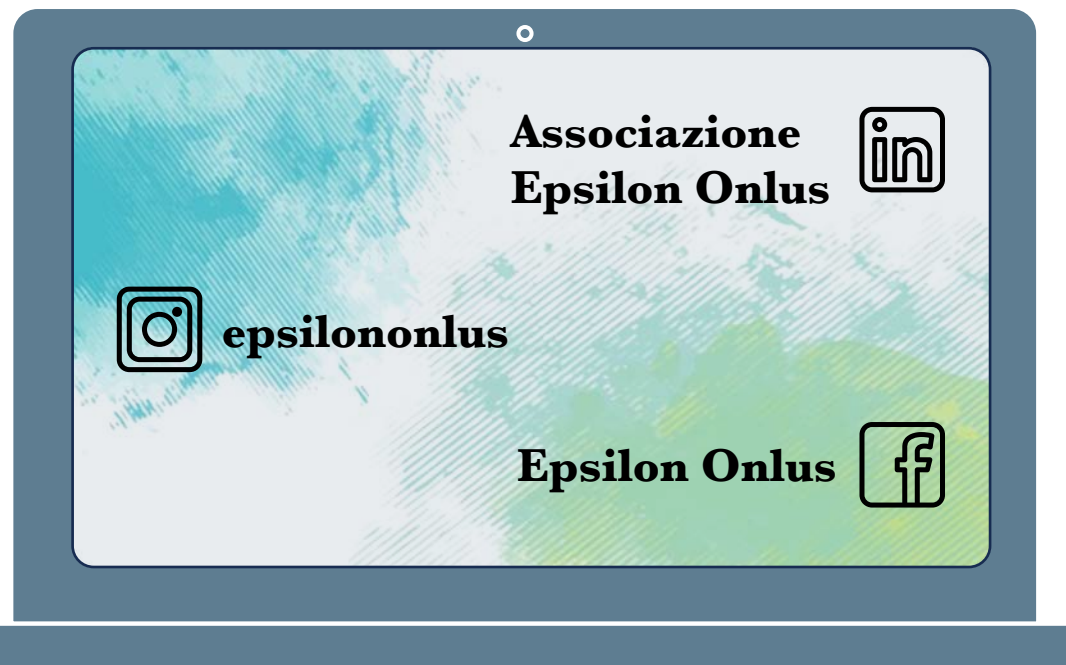
